



Registering your Interact Club

Rotary clubs can energize and inspire young leaders **ages 12-18** (middle and high schools) through service and encourage them to become responsible global citizens by supporting Interact clubs.

District 7950 is implementing a mandatory annual registration policy for each Interact Club identified in My Rotary as ACTIVE. This policy is to ensure advisors and students are insured under the umbrella of Rotary International's general liability insurance policy. If Interact Clubs are not registered with current information, **including** the advisor's name and contact information, the Interact Club will not be covered by RI per the organization's policy. Advisors and Interact Students would then be required to hold ALL events on the school grounds or require permission forms signed by parents to be covered under the school's general liability insurance policy.

'Sponsor clubs (Rotary Clubs in District 7950) must **update the contact information** of an Interact club adviser **annually** in My Rotary to maintain the club's active status and to continue receiving resources from Rotary International.' (reference to the policy)

Advisor- can be a Rotarian from the Sponsoring Club or an adult within the school where the Interact Club is located. Recommended to have both types of advisors to provide support and communication of service projects, challenges, accomplishments and recognition of the students' impact within the school and community.

Our focus is to identify all Interact Clubs thriving in District 7950, so each Club can receive the resources available from RI while ensuring the safety of each student and advisor.

The form located in My Rotary requires Club information, identification of the advisor, President's signature, and District Governor's signature.
